Challenger Island, dedicated to deep sea exploration, marine research and conservation, led by world-renowned scientists and experts.









Shambhala is structured through a group of Indonesian and Singaporean companies. The Indonesian Entity, PT. LII, holds the exclusive rights to develop and manage the entire archipelago for 35 years extendable to 95 years. All private island estate projects must work in joint partnership with PT. LII and the Singaporean holding company.









JOINT PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITY

- Investment funds for private island estates start at 3.5 million USD
- PT. LII builds the estate and manages daily operations
- Joint Partnership Agreement (JPA) lasting 15 years, renewable
- Investor receives 50% profit share on all net profits from the Singaporean subsidiary
- ROI dependant on rates charged by the estate
